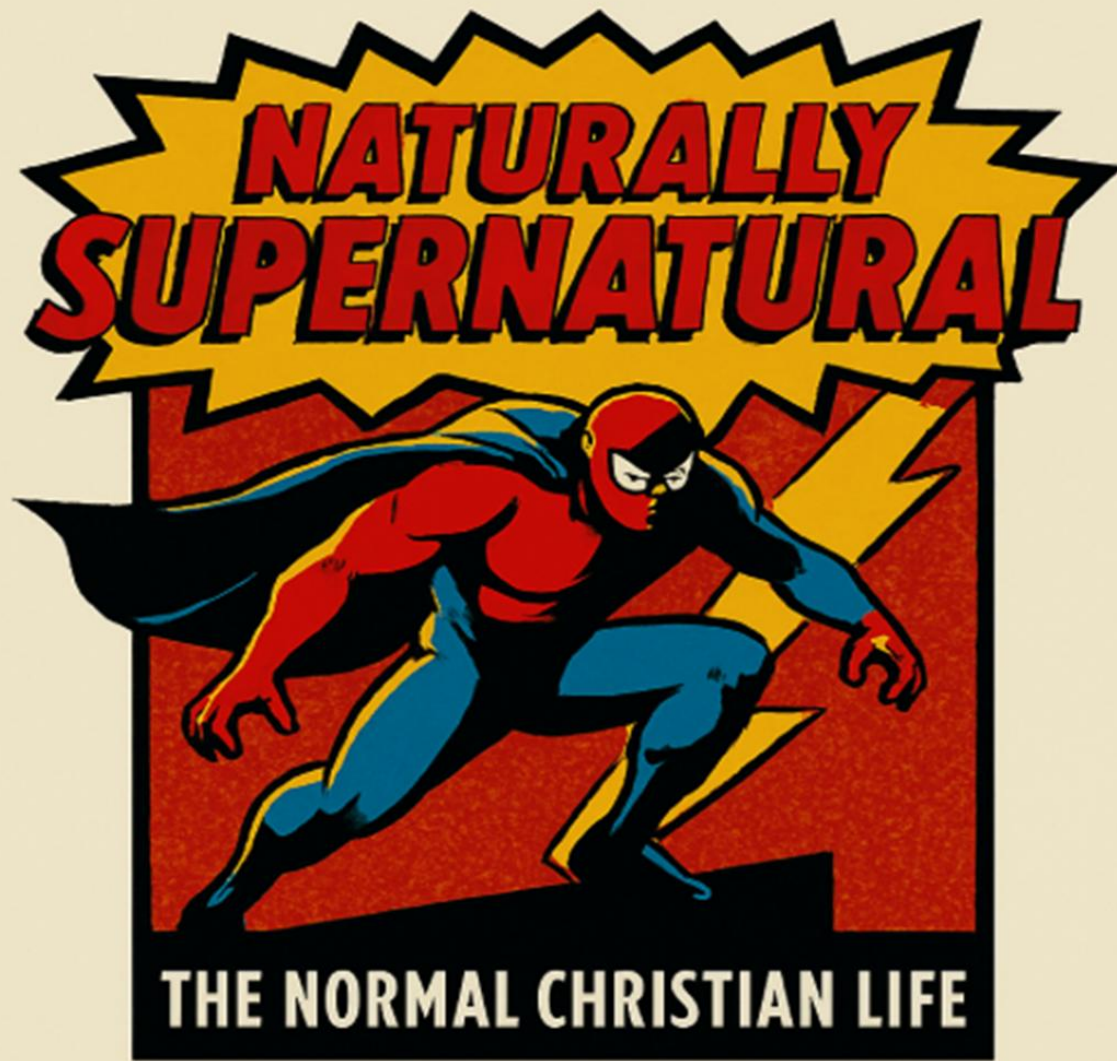

things above, not on earthly things.

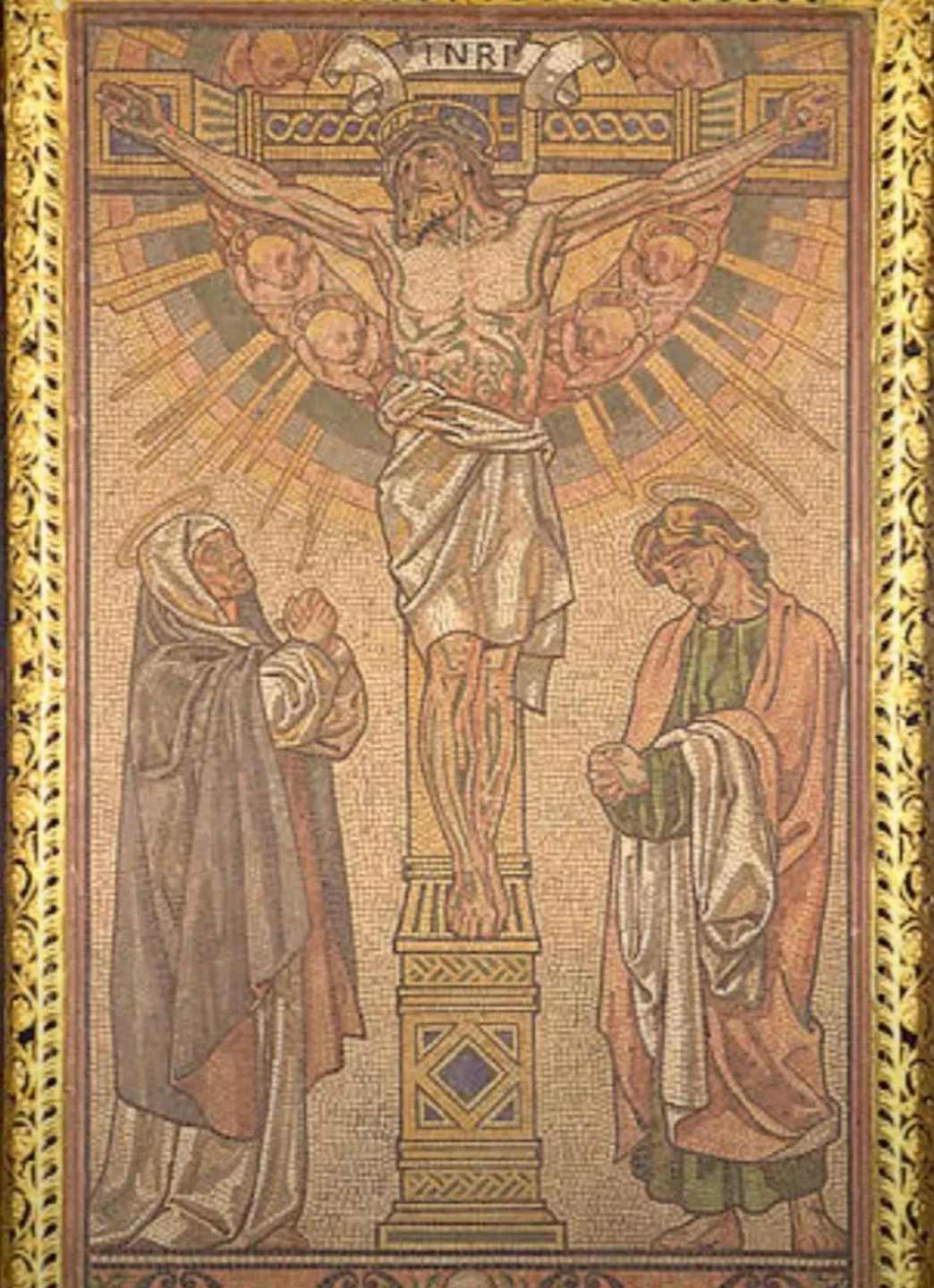
