








Psalm 19:1 Deuteronomy 6:4-15 Hebrews 3:15

Prophecy is:

"putting into human words what God brings to mind." Grudem

"if one rises early and a scriptural verse comes to mind this is a small prophecy." Rabbi Johann

In the New Testament, prophecy is understood as a Spirit-prompted utterance that conveys a message from God., for the purpose of edification, encouragement, consolation, conviction or guidance

2For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God. Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit. 3But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort.

Manageable a word to be tested

29 Two or three prophets should speak, and the others should weigh carefully what is said. 30And if a revelation comes to someone who is sitting down, the first speaker should stop. 31For you can all prophesy in turn so that everyone may be instructed and encouraged. 32The spirits of prophets are subject to the control of prophets
