IN HIS DEATH**

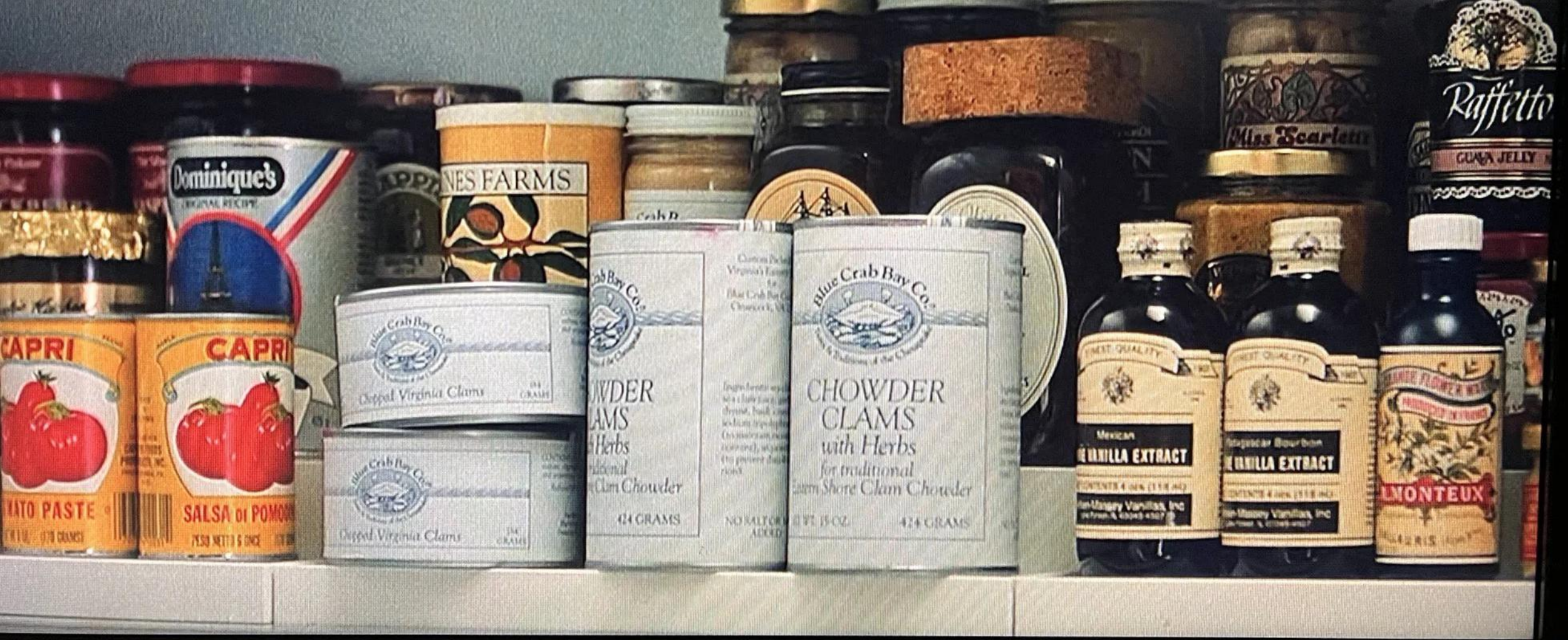
# We identify with him in his death

---
